QUINCE:

FLUTE:

BOTTOM:

QUINCE:

No,no. You have to play Pyramus. Is Robin Starveling her?

STARVELING:

I'm right here.

QUINCE:

SNOUT:

Here, Peter Quince.

QUINCE:
